1. Infiniz IT Solutions has agreed to undertake the Management Consulting of Placement Cell of SSV College of Arts and Science, Valayanchirangara from July 2019 to March 2020.
2. 4 days of visit would be conducted in a month by the team.
3. The training and placement activity would be provided at a rate of Rs 12,000 per month.
4. SSV College of Arts and Science, Valayanchirangara would provide the accommodation for the trainers during the tenure of the training if required.
5. The consulting fees would be paid by the college before the 5th day of each month.
6. Infiniz IT Solutions would be conducting at least 2 Placement Drives at SSV College of Arts and Science, Valayanchirangara for the trained students.
7. Infiniz IT Solutions would conduct the Placement Drive within 6 months of Training or a date agreed upon by both the parties.
8. Infiniz IT Solutions would provide a min of 5 opportunities to the 2020 pass out students who have attended the training session within 1 year of Training.
9. SSV College of Arts and Science, Valayanchirangara would take care of the local transport (within Ernakulam) and hospitality of the HRs who would be coming for the Campus Interview. Any other travel and accommodation requirement of HRs would be taken care by Infiniz IT Solutions.
10. The training would be conducted at a stretch or batch wise as mutually agreed by College and Company.
